All adults working in school need to adhere to the guidelines in the school behaviour policy and the main principles in this overview

***ALL STAFF will always praise children for desired behaviours e.g:***

*upholding the school aims*

*standing still on the whistle*

*lining up in silence*

*walking along the corridors*

*holding doors open*

*picking up jumpers and water bottles*

*being polite and respectful*

*showing kindness to staff and children*

*respecting school property*

*picking up litter and respecting the environment*

***ALL STAFF will always:***

*make at least one positive phone call home per week*

*send home at least one postcard per week*

*award team point to children across school as much as possible*

### **Golden Time:**

Golden Time takes place during Friday afternoon in classes with the class teacher to reward children for keeping our School Aims. We aim to promote to children that "Behaviour is their choice." Golden time will be an opportunity for children to work on a project of their choice or fun activity planned by the class teacher

Each child should take part in the full Golden Time session if they have kept the School Aims.

- Golden Time deducted should be in line with the flowchart guidelines. (5 minutes per piece of red writing)
- Red writing and amount of Golden Time lost should be recorded in the back of the behaviour book and signed by the adult giving the sanction

All children who do not lose any Golden Time during each term will receive a Certificate for keeping the Golden Rules. These will be presented in assembly and sent home to parents.

### **Team Point Reward System:**

At the end of each week team points are collected from each class and totalled. The winning colour team is then announced in Sparkle and Shine assembly on Friday afternoon. The children who are in the winning coloured team are given the extra reward of taking part in a sporting or creative activity run by teaching assistants and the sport apprentices. They also have the choice to stay in their own class if they wish to do so.
