Our English focus will be based on the poetry book 'Rumble in the jungle. In this book are a collection of poems about various jungle animals. We will be writing our own poems describing a lion, monkey or an elephant in our 'Big Write' session. This extended writing session will take place on Thursday morning. The children will be asked to include elements of VCOP (vocabulary, conjunctions, openers and punctuation) in order to improve their writing.

In Numeracy we will be continuing our work based on place value. We will be reading and writing 2-digit numbers in figures and words, e.g. 23 = twenty three $20 + 3$.

In P.E we will be continuing our gymnastic work.

In Science we will be learning about the different living conditions of various habitats and the reasons why certain animals live in these specific habitats.

In Geography we will be learning about the 7 continents of the world.

In Computing we will start our topic on coding.

In RE/PHSCE, we will be thinking about what challenges lie ahead this year and will be asking for God to help us face them.

Can we also remind parents to check the 6 spellings that should be stuck inside your child's RWI spelling log book. Each week your child will receive 6 new spellings on Wednesday and will be tested the following Monday.
