Dear Parents/Carers,

I have recently attended an E-twinning Conference in Budapest and made some fantastic school / teacher contacts across Europe. Together as Teachers, we have formed a project entitled: 'Being Sustainable' and have created an action plan to detail a range of related activities and time frames. Each of the involved schools will be placing their learning onto a secure E-Twinning portal, to share with one another (Please see the attached sheet for a list of involved schools).

The aims of our European project include:

- Developing pupil's deeper understanding and skill sets linked to 'sustainability'
- Enhancing motivation and engagement in a real life context
- Expanding pupil's digital literacy as a medium to communicate with partner schools
