


THE FAMOUS FIVES

Dear Parents/Carers,

What a fantastic first week for the Famous Fives! We've been very busy getting to know one another and have jumped straight into our learning. I am really proud of the exemplary attitudes that Year 5 have started the year with.



In English this week, we will continue with 'The Wolves in the Walls' as a stimulus for our learning. We will be learning the following things: how to use thesaurus (to collect adjectives and similes for description), how to use a variety of punctuation marks, how to punctuate dialogue accurately and how to summarise.

Last week in Maths, we completed a number of investigations around Roman Numerals. We can now create any number using Roman Numerals (ask us to show you at home)! We will be finishing off our work on Roman Numerals and moving onto Number and Place Value. Main Maths activities for this week are - to be able to read, write, order and compare numbers up to 1,000,000 (1 million) and be able to determine the value of each digit in numbers to 1,000,000 (1 million).

Curriculum activities for this week include - History: When was Elizabeth I on the throne? Science: To compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties. RE: Why do Christians believe God is worth worshipping?

- Homework will be set this Thursday and is due in on **Monday**.
- All Year 5 children are expected to read at home daily, practise weekly RWI spellings and practise their times tables. Make sure you log onto Times Tables Rock Stars this week as it's a great way to improve your child's recall!
