Ongoing daily activities

Reading

Please try to read with your child as often as possible, if you can aim for a little bit every day that would be brilliant. Ask your child questions to test their comprehension. Use the Canine Pal characters to help you do this.

Teaching tip for your child

When writing instructions we start them with a bossy verb. This word tell you how to do something. For example, put, water, get or chop. We would talk about bossy verbs before writing

We have attached a sheet to give an example of what the instructions could be like. The red words show how our vocabulary could be improved. There is also a simple version.

Ideas for writing instructions

How to make more Dandelions

You will need:

A cloche

A dandelion

The wind

Watering can

1. Put a cloche over the dandelion to protect it.
2. Water the dandelion every day and pick (**remove**) off the bugs. (**insects**)
3. Leave the dandelion alone and do not nibble.
4. Take the dandelion up a big (**large**) hill and blow the seeds.

Simple version

1. Put a cloche on the dandelion
2. Water the dandelion and pick off the bugs.
3. Leave the dandelion and do not nibble.
4. Blow the seeds.



New figures revealed on the 7th April by the Department of Transport show that only a very small proportion of people in the UK are still travelling during the lockdown period that the government have imposed during the COVID-19 outbreak. Visits to shops, museums and cafes in the UK have fallen by 85% since the coronavirus outbreak, according to data shared by Google. The government has supported Google in using data in this way.
