Your child's weekly spellings will be on the reverse of the homework folder. They will also be accessible on the school website. Please practise these with your child in preparation for a weekly test on Wednesday. There will also be a weekly times table test on Friday. Again, the multiplication table to practise each week is written underneath the weekly spellings on the yearly grid. New reading books will be sent home on Fridays.

There will be a one-way system in place for entering and exiting the school site. Please enter through the top gate and leave school through the double gate (adjacent to the top gate.) Please arrive at 8.45am but not earlier. These gates will be locked at 9am promptly.
