

Dear Parents/Carers,

What a fantastic first week for the Famous Fives! We've been very busy getting to know one another, the expectations in Year 5 and the new routines in school. I am really proud of the exemplary attitudes and kindness that we have started the year with.



In English this week, we will continue with 'The Wolves in the Walls' as a stimulus for our learning. We will be learning the following things: how to use thesaurus (to collect adjectives and similes for description), how to use a variety of punctuation marks, how to punctuate dialogue accurately and how to summarise.

This week in Maths, we will be starting some learning on **Number and Place Value**. Main Maths activities for this week are - to be able to read, write, order and compare numbers up to 1,000,000 (1 million) and be able to determine the value of each digit in numbers to 1,000,000 (1 million).

The children's topic this term is the "Enchanting Elizabethans". Curriculum activities for this week include - History: Who is Queen Elizabeth I and when was she on the throne? Science: How can we sort different materials? RE: What is God's character like?
