


THE FAMOUS FIVES

Dear Parents/Carers,

In English this week, we will complete our unit of learning on the Wolves in the Walls as a stimulus for our learning. We will be building up to writing our own diary entry as Lucy on Friday. We will be learning to build cohesion across paragraphs using a variety of openers and to be able to explain your understanding about what you've read through a presentation. Main activities for our SPAG warm ups include relative clauses, adverbs and colons to introduce a list.



In Maths, we will be continuing our learning on rounding and we'll be introduced to "Roxie the Rounding Rabbit" and her rounding song. By the end of the week, we will know how to round using numbers within 1,000,000. In our Maths Meetings, we will be consolidating our knowledge of reading, writing, comparing and ordering numbers up to 1,000,000.



Curriculum activities for this week include- RE: Understanding God: How do Christians worship God?? History: Why was the Spanish Armada launched against English? PE: Gymnastics and dance
