I hope you had a lovely weekend.

In English we made an excellent start with our new topic about climate change. We watched different videos, learnt some new key vocabulary and read a text about Greta Thunberg. The children started writing their poems with the title "If I were in charge of the world" and came up with some excellent ideas.

**In spelling** we will continue following the Read Write Inc spelling scheme and look at a new spelling rule. The spellings for this week are: **adventure, future, creature, nature, temperature, mixture**. The spelling test will be on Friday and the children will bring home the results for you to see how they've done.

**In Reciprocal Reading** we will read a text about plastic pollution. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions.

**Please remember to read at home with your child and sign their reading journal.** These will be checked every Monday during our reading for pleasure session. If the children read 3 times they get a reading token and are entered into a raffle which is drawn every Friday.

**In maths** we will finish the Addition and Subtraction unit. The times tables test will be on Friday and the focus will be the **8 times tables**.

In science we will learn about the human skeleton.

In RE we will continue learning about Hinduism.

In history we will learn about Stonehenge.

**PE days are Wednesday and Friday. Please do not forget to bring the PE kit on these days.**

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

In a few weeks we will be putting up the Christmas tree and some Christmas decorations in our classroom. If the children would like to bring something from home please bring it by the end of this week in a plastic bag. We will keep the decorations safe until we are ready to use them to make it safe for everyone.

**The photographer will be in school on Thursday to take individual photos.** You will receive an email with more information about this from the school office.

Next Monday is our school trip. I will send some information about it later this week.
