This week in **English** we will start working with a new non-fiction text about Skara Brae and start gathering skills for our next piece of writing which will be a holiday brochure.

The spellings for this week are: **stitch, wrap, option, version, small, tail**. The spelling test will be on Friday and the children will bring home the results for you to see how they've done.

**In Reciprocal Reading** we will read a text about Skara Brae. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions.

Please remember to read at home with your child and sign their **reading journal**. It would be great if the children could bring their reading book and journal to school every day. We are going to set up a book swap box in our class so if the children could please bring a book that they would like to recommend and share with their friends that would be wonderful.

**In maths** we will start a new unit about Multiplication and Division. The times tables test will be on Friday and the focus will remain the **8 times tables**.

In science we will continue with the Animals Including Humans topic.

In RE we will learn about the main Hindu beliefs and Hindu place of worship.

In history we will learn about Skara Brae and life in the Neolithic period.

PE days are Wednesday and Friday. The children will need to remember to bring their PE kits on these days.

Homework this week will be My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

It is **anti-bullying week** this week. The children will take part in a range of activities and we will also have a class discussion about bullying. The children can wear odd socks each day this week.
