


The Smartest Giants in Tankersley

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome Back! We hope you have all had a lovely Easter break. This half term our new topic is growing.



This week in English, the children will be introduced to the text Jack and the beanstalk. The children will be reading and learning the story. They will also look at the character of Jack. They will follow a story map and add in their own actions. The children will be introduced to spelling words with the prefix un.

In Maths, we will be counting forwards and backwards in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. The children will be introduced to multiplication by recognising equal and unequal groups. They will make different representations of groups using apparatus to understand multiplication as repeated addition. For example, 4 groups of 2 can be written as $2+2+2+2=8$

In our creative curriculum, we will begin fruit tasting so that we can design our own fruit kebabs. In ICT, we will continue our learning of spreadsheets and learn how to add, move and lock images. In history we will complete our learning on what life was like for a knight and compare it to our own. In PHSE, we will be looking at the feeling of jealousy
