This week in **English** we will finish working with the Ancient Greek myth about Pandora's Box and complete our assessed piece of writing which will be a formal letter.

The spellings for this week are: **sentence, busy, entry, group, believe, guard**. The spelling test will be on Friday and the children will bring home the results for you to see how they've done.

**In Reciprocal Reading** we will read another Ancient Greek myth. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

Please continue reading regularly at home. The children can read the book sent from school or if they prefer they can read their own books, but **please sign the reading journal** so we can have a record of their reading activity.

**In maths** we will continue with the unit about Fractions.

The times tables test will be on Friday and the focus will be the **6, 7, 8 and 9 times tables**. Please continue to encourage your child to practice at home.

In science we will continue with our topic about Plants and we will learn about what plants need to grow.

In RE we will continue with the topic of Christianity and learn about the Trinity.

In music we are learning to play the ukulele and the children are really enjoying it.

**PE days are Wednesday and Friday**. Please remember to bring a PE kit on these days.

Homework this week will be on My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

On the **19<sup>th</sup> May** we will have a **DT workshop** and make a Greek Lyre with a DT specialist. A letter has been sent out about it as there is a small contribution towards this activity. Thank you to everyone who has already paid. If haven't, please organise payment before the date of the workshop.

Our last school trip will take place on **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July** and we will visit the science adventure centre Magna. A letter about it will be sent out before the end of this half term.
