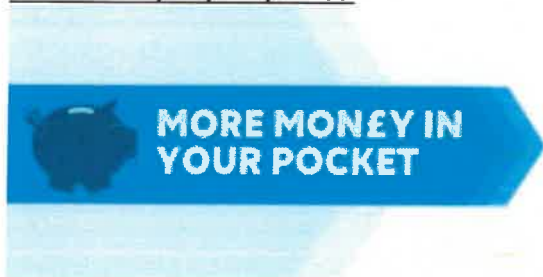
This Friday, the family of Mrs. Kirk will be visiting school, to open the bench that we purchased with contributions from staff and families. So, thank you so much for your support with this.

More money in your pocket.

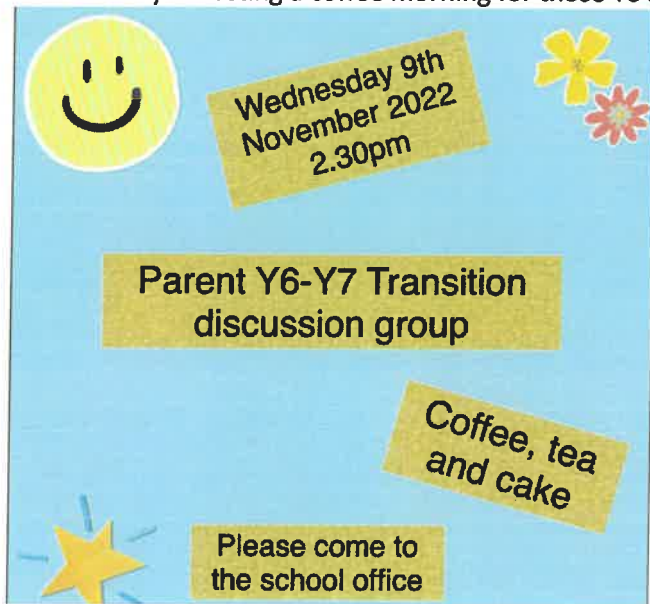
