As you know, road safety is very important, even more so near schools where parents often park to pick up their children by the school gates, which makes it harder to see cars driving towards the places where other children may be crossing.


I will write to Sheffield City Council about your worries, because I know they want children to be safe when they are walking and cycling to school.
