Take / find photographs of your family. This could include cousins and grandparents as well as your immediate family. Be prepared to talk about your family; What are their names? Where do they live? Do they speak any other languages?

Go on a number hunt. Which numbers can you find? Have a go at writing some of the numerals. Can you match the correct number of objects to each numeral?

Go for a walk with your family. Can you find an Oak or Ash tree? Collect leaves, acorns, conkers or fir cones. Bring them to school for us to investigate the different textures and smells.

Find out who has the biggest feet in your family. You could draw around the feet and put them in order! Or you could do some shoe rubbings to help you find out.
