







T1b - Judaism & Incarnation

Vocabulary	How will I remember it?	What is it?
Judaism		A religion followed by Jewish people. They believe in one God.
Hanukkah		A Jewish festival to celebrate the rededication of the second temple in Jerusalem.
Menorah		A candelabrum used in Jewish worship, especially one with eight branches and a central socket used at Hanukkah.
Christingle		A lighted candle symbolizing Christ as the light of the world. Christingles are oranges wrapped in red tape, decorated with dried fruit or sweets, with a candle on the top.
Incarnation		Incarnation means that Jesus is God in the flesh, and that in Jesus, God came to live among humans.
Epiphany		Epiphany is celebrated 12 days after Christmas on 6th January and is the time when Christians remember the Wise Men who visited Jesus.
