I hope you had a lovely weekend. The children worked really hard last week and enjoyed learning more about the Stone Age.

In English we will link our learning to history and work with a non-fiction text about Stonehenge and we will start gathering skills for writing a formal letter to Mrs Harrison.

The spellings for this week are: **peculiar, popular, breath, breathe, woman, women.** Please help your child to practice the words so they are ready for the spell check on Friday.

In Reciprocal Reading we will be reading a text about Hajj and we will be answering a variety of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

The children need to read at least 3 times a week in order to receive a reading token. Please sign the reading journal and make sure your child brings it to school. The journals are checked on Mondays when I also swap the reading books.

In maths we will continue learning about place value. This week we will be comparing objects and numbers, ordering numbers up to a 1000 and counting in 50s. The times tables test will be on Friday and the focus will be the 2 5, and 10 times tables.

In RE we will learn about the 5 pillars of Islam.

In science we will learn about light.

PE days are Monday and Wednesday. The children will need to bring their PE kits on these days.

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. The homework will set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

On Tuesday 19th October we will have a special scooter skills session for our class. Can children who have scooters please bring them in? If your child has not got a scooter they will be able to borrow one.

On Tuesday 24th October we are organising a walk to school event to promote active travel. Children need to wear something bright instead of their uniform.
