This week the Shining Stars will be deepening their understanding of counting and cardinality in the provision. They will also be starting their daily RWInc sessions and practising reading their new reading books. The Shining Stars will also be creating their own time capsules, starting with drawing self-portraits using pencils and pencil crayons, then moving onto measuring height with a piece of string and writing about themselves. This time capsule will then be opened when the children are in Year 6 ready to move onto their next phases of education.
