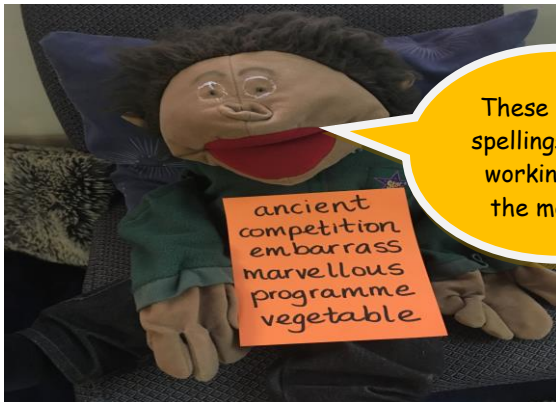

Main activities for English are- To be able to use some of our writing skills to write a diary entry as one of the characters from the ball, to discuss what makes a piece of writing informal, to write informal question tags and to be able to identify relative clauses and relative pronouns.

In Maths our theme is Number and Place Value. Our Maths Meetings for this half term will focus on fluency of numbers and place value.

Curriculum activities for this week include- RE-How did God use Moses to bring about freedom and Moses- the 10 commandments? History- Romans: How did the Romans conquer Britain? Science- Light: An experiment to show how light travels.
