In **English** we will be starting a new project based on the book 'The Journey Home' written by Fran Preston Gannon. The book is about a group of endangered animals journeying to escape the threats to their lives. They find refuge on a desert island where they meet an animal now extinct - the Dodo. We will be writing noun phrases to describe a mystery animal. We will also be identifying different types of sentences: questions, statements, commands and exclamations and writing a fact-file about a Dodo.

In **Maths** we will be flexibly partitioning numbers to 100, writing numbers in expanded form and counting in 10s and 1s on a number line.

In **P.E.** we will be continuing our multi-skills – throwing and catching work. We will also be taking part in gymnastics with Mrs Crossley.

In Music we will be learning our songs for the harvest festival.

In **Computing** we will continue with our coding work, we will be discussing key vocabulary used in coding.
