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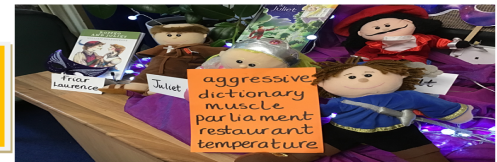


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These are the spellings we are working on at the moment.
