# Mandir, mosque and synagogue visit in Bradford

#### Dear Parents / Carers

As part of our R.E. topics on Hinduism, Islam and Judaism the children in Class 3 and 4 will be visiting a Hindu temple (Mandir), a mosque and a synagogue in Bradford on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November. The purpose of this visit is to enrich their knowledge of these religions and enable them to learn how Hindus, Muslims and Jews worship. We feel that this trip will provide an exciting and valuable opportunity for the children to broaden their understanding of other cultures. (Please see the attached letter from the faith leaders of Sheffield which further explains why it is important for children to learn about different faiths.)

As we are visiting places of worship which are used by members of the faith community, it is important that we are sensitive to this and show respect by conducting ourselves in a respectful manner at all times. The children will need to wear school uniform (please wear tights with a skirt or a dress).

There will be a contribution cost of £22.00 per child. This cost will cover the transport and the educational tour guides. Please make your payment on the School Comms payment system before the  $20^{th}$  October.

Children will need to be in school for 8.15am for registration at 8.20am. The coach will leave school at 8.30am prompt. WE EXPECT TO RETURN TO SCHOOL BETWEEN 3.30 and 4PM.

#### Your child will need:

- PACKED LUNCH (NO GLASS BOTTLES PLEASE). Please order it on the system the usual way
- SCHOOL UNIFORM, SUITABLE FOOTWEAR
- TRAVEL SICKNESS MEDICATION if your child suffers from travel sickness please ensure they have taken their medication, or alternatively speak to their teacher to make alternative arrangements.
