In **English** we will start gathering skills for our next assessed piece of writing which will be a holiday brochure about Skara Brae.

In spelling we will continue following the Read Write Inc spelling scheme and look at a new spelling rule. The spellings for this week are: explanation, observation, information, preparation, temptation, reservation. The spelling test will be on Friday.

In Reciprocal Reading we will read a text about Diwali which links to our RE topic about Hinduism. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

Please remember to read at home with your child, sign their **reading journal** and send it to school every day.

In maths we will continue with the unit about Multiplication and Division. The times tables test will be on Friday and the focus will be the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

In science we will continue with the Animals Including Humans topic and learn about muscles.

In RE we will learn about the main Hindu beliefs.

In music we will continue learning about reggae.

PE days are Monday and Wednesday. Please make sure PE kits are in on these days. Some children keep forgetting to bring their PE kits and it is not safe or appropriate for them to do PE in their uniform.
