For the spelling test please revise the words from this half term. There will be 20 words in the test altogether.

Please remember to read at home with your child and sign their reading journal.

In maths we will continue learning about Multiplication and Division. We will still have the usual times tables test on Friday and the focus will be the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.

In science we will continue with the Animals Including Humans topic and learn about the functions of a skeleton and a healthy diet.

In geography we will learn about our local area.

In RE we will continue learning about Hinduism.

Homework this week will be My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.
