This week the children will be learning about Hinduism and the festival of Diwali, listening to and sequencing the story of 'Rama and Sita' and starting to create their own Diva lamps. They will also be practising an Indian dance and creating Rangoli and Mehndi hand patterns. As part of the children's maths learning, they will be exploring tessellating, ABB and ABBC repeating patterns and number bonds to 4.
