This week, the children will be deepening their learning about the composition of 4, representing and recording their learning in different ways. They will also be starting to explore whole number 5. The children will also be focusing upon the Oliver Jeffers' book: The Way Back Home and in particular the characters and plot, which they will be re-telling. The children will be writing a list of things they might need if they were going to rescue an alien from the moon, just like the boy did. The Shining Stars will be completing their learning about Hinduism and Diwali, then listening to the Christian Nativity story, practising their own Nativity; acting, speaking and singing! The children will be starting their design technology project-planning, designing a slider mechanism, to move Nativity characters along a background, in order to tell part of the Nativity story to a Nursery friend.
