It was then the turn of Key Stage 1, who have been so resilient as a lot of the actors and actresses have been poorly. Children in Y3 have been stepping in to help!

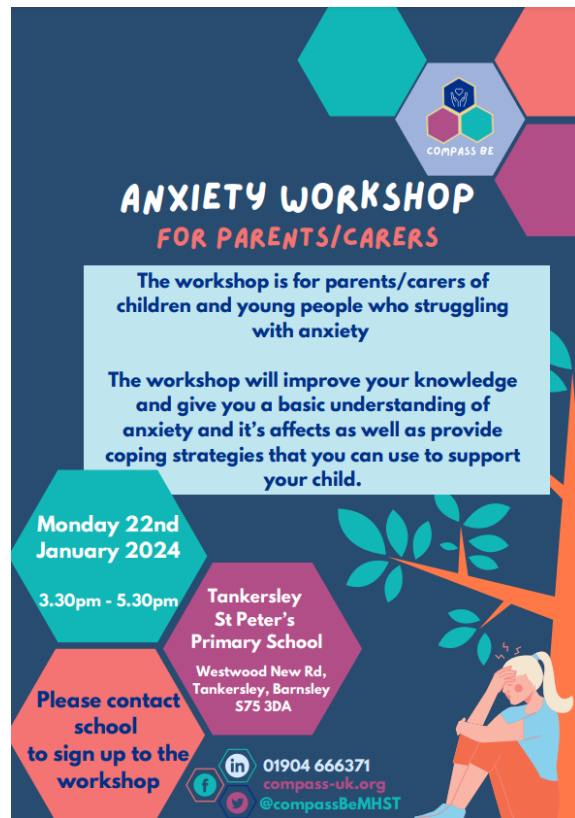


Year 4 have been on a trip to Hoyland library, and the bus driver said that they were a credit to the school. At the library
