This week we will continue with the assessments. Last week the children completed their formal assessment in reading, arithmetic and spelling and this week we will complete the reasoning and problem solving math test and the grammar tests.

In spelling we will continue following the Read Write Inc spelling scheme and look at some new spelling rules. The spellings for this week are: chemist, character, anchor, chaos, school, stomach. Please remember to read at home with your child and sign their reading journal. It is really important that the reading books and journals are sent to school every day so they can be checked, filled in and books can be swapped.

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.
