This week in **English** we will start working with the story of Beowulf which links to our new history topic about the Anglo-Saxons. We will learn about powerful verbs, synonyms, the show not tell technique, how to build tension and we will start planning our next writing piece which will be a hero and monster story.

In spelling we will continue following the Read Write Inc spelling scheme and look at a new spelling rule. The spellings for this week are: **chef**, **machine**, **moustache**, **brochure**, **chalet**, **parachute**. The spelling test will be on Friday as usual.

In Reciprocal Reading we will read a text about the Anglo Saxons. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

Please remember to read at home with your child and sign their **reading journal**. These will be **checked every Monday during our reading for pleasure session**. The children can bring their own book or magazine for this session or they can choose one from our class library.

In maths we will continue with the unit about Multiplication and Division. The times tables test will be on Friday and the focus will be the **11 times tables**.

In science we will start our new topic about Rocks and Soils.

In history we will start our new topic about the Anglo-Saxons.

In RE we will start our new learning block about Christianity and will focus on the Creation story.

PE days are now Wednesday and Thursday. The children will need to bring to school their PE kits on these days.

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.
