This week in **English** we will continue working with the text called Stone Girl, Bone Girl by Laurence Anholt which is about Mary Anning, the Victorian fossil hunter from Lyme Regis in Dorset.

The spellings for this week are: surprise, address, circle, extreme, increase, family.

In Reciprocal Reading we will read a text about garden birds. We will learn some new and interesting words and answer a range of comprehension questions linked to the Canine Pals.

Please continue reading at home with your child, remember to sign their reading journal and send it to school every day. Reading at home is absolutely essential as it will help the children develop their vocabulary, improve their spelling and sentence construction.

In maths we will continue with our topic about length and perimeter. The times tables test will be on Friday and the focus will be the 6 times tables.

In science we will continue learning about different types of rocks including igneous, metamorphic and sedimentary and we will do an experiment demonstrating how rocks are formed using chocolate.

In RE we will continue learning about Creation and Fall.

In art we will paint a watercolour scene.

Homework this week will be on My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.
