Happy New Year and welcome back to an exciting new term!

This half term's enquiry question is: How does Winter Weather affect us?

This week the children will be writing about their Christmas break and applying their phonics and tricky word knowledge within their sentence writing. The children will also be brainstorming the above enquiry question, to demonstrate their prior knowledge. They will be predicting what will happen to ice in different places around school. During the next couple of weeks, the children will be testing ice changes; observing what happens and giving their explanations. In maths the children will be exploring zero in relation to numbers 1-5 and then 1-10. They will also be comparing numbers to 7, using the maths vocabulary: more than, less than, fewer and the same, creating 'Five-wise' and 'Pairwise' patterns. There will be gloop sensory play as well as a 'Winter home' role-play area, with small world sets too. The children will be enjoying lots of child-initiated learning through play and shared co-construction with friends.
