This week the children will be writing a recount of their half term holiday, applying their phonics and tricky word skills as well as using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. In maths, the children will be discriminating between and representing numbers 8, 9 and 10, recording their learning in different ways. The children will be learning about what helps human beings to be healthy and grow: preparing repeating pattern fruit kebabs, tasting the fruits and creating a bar chart to show class favourites. There will also be learning about the stages of human development across a life span. As usual, the children will be initiating their own play in the provision, exploring and recording their ideas both in and outside.
