Here's what the Famous Fives are learning about this week:

In **English**, we are continuing our work on The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe. We are looking at how to use inverted commas correctly and use a wide range of punctuation within speech. We are also learning how to alter the position of our reporting clauses in a sentence and use a variety of verbs and adverbs.
