This week in **English** we will continue gathering skills for our next piece of writing which is a retelling of the Ancient Greek myth about the Minotaur.

In Reciprocal Reading we will read the Ancient Greek myth about Theseus and the Minotaur.

In maths we will start a new topic about telling time. I am sure you will agree that this is an important life skill so if the children could practice at home too it would be great.

The times tables test will be on Friday and we are revising all our times tables. The children have set themselves their individual targets and it is important to continue working on these and keep getting better each week. Please continue to encourage your child to practice at home.

In history we will learn about the Greek Gods.

In RE we will continue learning about baptism.

In music we will continue practicing our songs for the Ancient Greece assembly.

Homework this week will be on My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

This Wednesday is our school trip to Bradford and we will be visiting different places of worship. The children need to wear their full uniform and bring a packed lunch but they do not need any spending money. We will leave at 9 am and aim to return for 3.30 pm so the children need to be at school for the usual time of 8.45 am.
