





## RECEPTION CLASS NEWSLETTER-Monday 29th April 2024

This week the children will be learning lots of new vocabulary, facts and information about the Amazonian Rainforest. The children will also be taking part in the hands-on animal handling Zoolab experience, where they will be using their senses to investigate creatures that would naturally be living in the Rainforest. The Shining Stars will also be creating Rainforest collages, exploring a range of materials, tools and techniques. In maths the children will be focusing upon subtraction and it's linked vocabulary: subtract, minus, take away, less, fewer. The children will also be finishing designing and planning their rain gauges before creating them, using a range of drilling, assembling and joining skills. In R.E the children will be learning about the fish and dove symbols. As usual, there will be lots of child-initiated learning in and outdoors.
