





## RECEPTION CLASS NEWSLETTER-Tuesday 7th May 2024

This week the children will be evaluating their completed DT rain gauges and placing them outside, ready to measure rainfall in Tankersley. They will also be listening to different fiction books by Eileen Browne. The Shining Stars will be writing in response to one of the poems from 'My Village: Rhymes from around the World,' writing a letter to one of the characters, whilst demonstrating their knowledge about their own locality and other places. The Shining Stars will be deepening their knowledge about doubling and representing this in different ways. In R.E the children will be discussing the symbol of the candle/light in Christianity and recalling past learning about Diwali (Diva lamps). They will also be creating their own symbols to reflect their own lives, interests and beliefs. The children will be layering materials as they create Christian symbol collages of fish, doves and candles. The children will also be exploring torch light in the Rainforest tent. There will be lots of child-initiated play in and outdoors as usual.
