Dear Parents/Carers,

Last week the children had so much fun making their fruit kebab. This week in English, the children will be completing their own instructions of how to make a fruit kebab so they can share it with other children. They will also be writing their own Jack and the beanstalk stories too.

In Maths, we will begin a new unit of learning for multiplication and division. The children will learn how to count forwards and backwards in 2's, 5's and 10's. They will also be introduced to making equal groups.

In our creative curriculum, we will be evaluating our fruit kebabs. In Science, we will begin planting our seeds and thinking about what is growing in our school grounds. In RE, we will be looking at some of the key stories in the Gospels and thinking about what these stories mean to Christians.

Please could children have PE kits in school on Monday. Our PE lesson is on a Tuesday and Friday. As the weather becomes warmer we will have our PE lessons outside. Please could your child have a pair of trainers for this.

Just a little reminder that it is the National Phonics screening test after the half term break. Please could you make sure that you are reading regularly with your child and practising the sound cards. We also send out weekly phonics videos for the children to watch.
