





## RECEPTION CLASS NEWSLETTER-Monday 24th June 2024

This week the Shining Stars will be focusing their literacy learning on the story 'Supertato' by Sue Hendra and Paul Linnet. They will be responding to the Evil Pea's antics in the classroom home corner and writing letters to the villain! There will be a superhero small world area as the children use their imagination to develop narratives. The children will also be creating their own Supertato models on the Studio Space. In maths, the children will be learning about pairs and solving pair problems, whilst applying their previous doubling, halving and odd and even knowledge. As usual the children will be choosing their learning and playing in the provision, collaborating and extending their vocabulary and ideas.
