In maths we will revise all the different topics we have learnt about this term and focus a bit more on telling time as the children still find it quite difficult. Please encourage them to practice telling the time at home too.

The times tables test will be on Friday. The focus is now **ALL the times tables** and the children need to beat their previous best times. Please use TT Rockstars to practice.

We will continue learning about Forces and Magnets in science, about the Bible in RE and about the UK in geography.

Homework this week will be a reading comprehension. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

On Wednesday we will welcome visitors from the Hand to Mouth Charity in school who will work with the children on a project linked to RE.

On Thursday we are having a Green Day in school. The children will have a variety of lessons with different teachers and learn about the environment, recycling and healthy lifestyles.

Next Tuesday is our school trip to Magna. We will explore the exhibits to deepen our scientific knowledge, take part in an interactive workshop and also spend time in the adventure playground and the water park. The children will not need to wear uniform for this trip. They are going to get very wet in the water park so will need to bring a full change of clothes, a towel and some crocs or sandals.
