The Shining Stars will be exploring the composition of the whole number 10. In Literacy the children will be extending their independent writing, applying all of their phonics and tricky word skills, as well as remembering finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. The children will also be listening to lots of fairy tales.

This will give the children opportunities to ask questions and gain new knowledge about who helps to keep us safe.
