

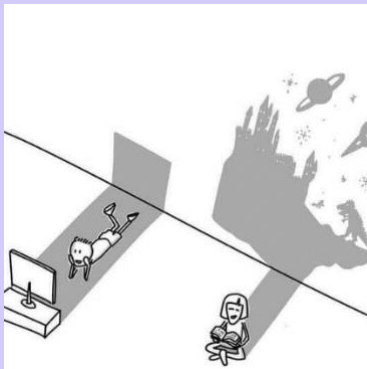

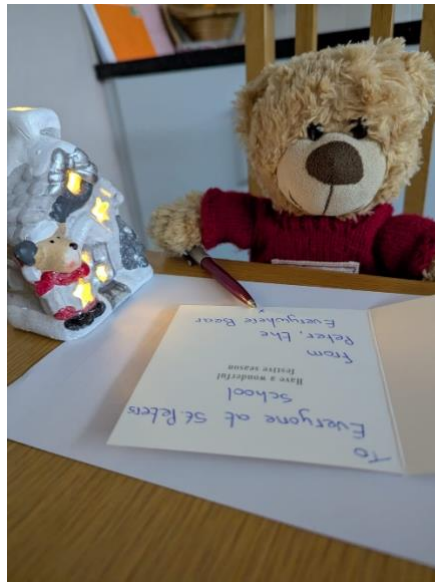

After School Provision

We are delighted to share that in January 2025 we will be partnering with Little Explorers to provide additional after school care, here on site at Tankersley St Peter's Primary School. We will continue to run our traditional after-school clubs for Reception children to Year 6, that can be booked via the gateway app. These will run from 3.30pm - 4.30pm and charged at £4 per session.

Alongside this, Little Explorers will run the following childcare sessions on our premises for Nursery to Year 6 children:

3.30pm - 4.30pm - £5.00
4.30pm - 5.30pm - £5.00
3.30pm - 5.30pm - £10.00

Children are more than welcome to attend a school run after school club till 4.30pm, then join the Little Explorers childcare facility until 5.30pm.
