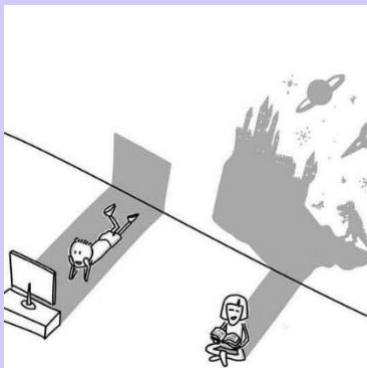

So far, this year's weather has been tricky! Today, it is wind. Yet, we have had snow, ice and flooding!



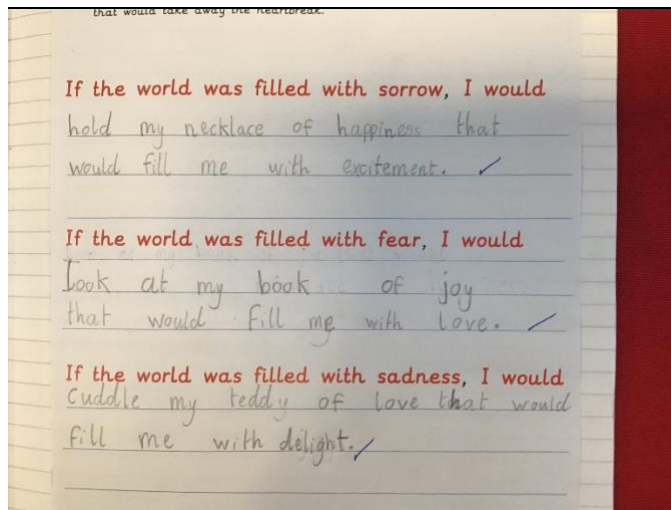
