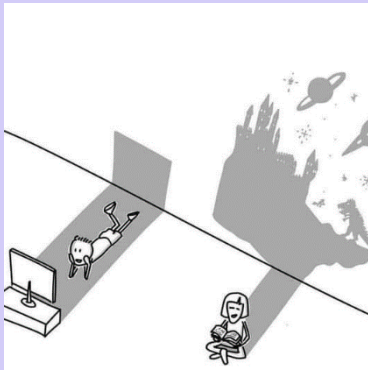


Dates for the diary
