We will be having a school disco for both KS1, FS and KS2 on the 21<sup>st</sup> of March.

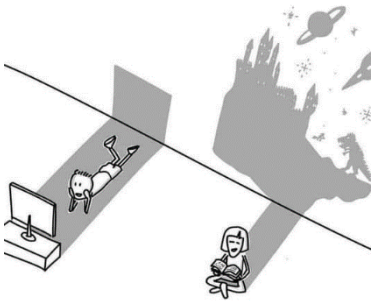
