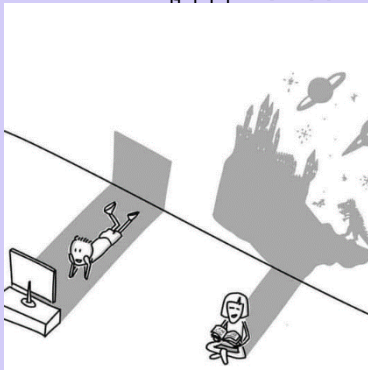
22.4.25 School begins for the summer term
