my Saviour and my hope is in you all day long.**

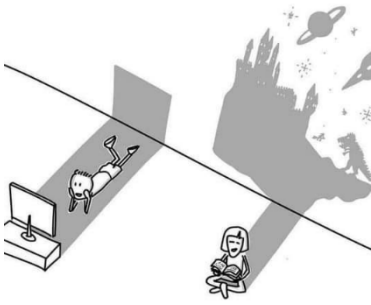
Good afternoon Everyone,
