This week the children will be gaining greater familiarity with 'The Great Paper Caper' story by Oliver Jeffers and writing their own invitations to Nursery teachers and children, inviting them to their own paper aeroplane competition. In maths, the children will be deepening their understanding and comparing amounts as well as matching numerals to quantity and taking part in maths meetings. The children will be choosing lots of their own learning in and outdoors. In R.E the children will be continuing their learning about different families and exploring how Hindus show that they are a family. As usual there will be a high priority placed upon wellbeing and the children's personal, social and emotional development through circle times and interactive learning, using our '1 Decision' resources and supporting children in the moment during their play.
