In **English** we will be starting a new project based on the book 'The Journey Home' written by Fran Preston Gannon. The book is about a group of endangered animals journeying to escape the threats to their lives. They find refuge on a desert island where they meet an animal now extinct - the Dodo. We will be writing noun phrases to describe a mystery animal. We will also be identifying different types of sentences: questions, statements, commands and exclamations and writing a fact-file about a Dodo.

In **Maths** we will be flexibly partitioning numbers to 100, writing numbers in expanded form and counting in 10s and 1s on a number line.

In **PE** we will be developing our throwing & catching skills as well as learning how to balance in gymnastics.

In Music we will be learning our songs for the harvest festival.

In Computing we will continue with Route Explorers, we will be writing instructions to complete more than one step of a route at once.

In Science we will be investigating what lives in our local habitat.

In Geography we will be learning about the main oceans of our world and locating them on a map.

In **Art** we will be working on our drawing skills by completing both 'continuous line' and 'blind' sketches.

In R.E. we will be finishing our work on the story of Jonah and will be reflecting on what it teaches us about God.
