This week in **English** we will continue working with the text called First Drawing by Mordicai Gerstein which also links to our topic about the Stone Age and complete our next independent piece of writing which will be a recount.

The spellings for this week are: **stitch, wrap, option, version, small, tail**. The spelling test will be on Friday.

In **Reciprocal Reading** we will read an information text, learn new vocabulary and answer a range of comprehension questions.

In **maths** we will start a new unit about Multiplication and Division. We are starting to learn a new times table this week and it will be the **8 times table**.

In science we will continue with the Animals Including Humans topic and learn about bones in the human body.

In RE we will learn about the main Hindu beliefs and the Hindu place of worship.

In music we will learn about reggae music and play the glockenspiels.

PE days have changed and are now Wednesday and Thursday. The children will need to remember to come in their PE kits on these days.

Homework this week will be My Maths. It will be set on Thursday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.
