
RECEPTION CLASS NEWSLETTER-Monday 3rd November 2025

This half term's enquiry question: How do others celebrate?







Welcome back to a new and exciting half term!

This week the children are learning all about the significance of Remembrance Sunday. They will be designing their own medals and labelling them, whilst extending their vocabulary through discussing word meanings e.g sacrifice, bravery. The children will be creating a whole class poem and hand print poppy. In maths, the children will be considering the 'whole' and 'parts' of objects and numbers. They will be continuing their mastery learning surrounding representation of numerals and number bonds/patterns to 3. They will be recording their findings using number sentences, bar models and part, part, whole models. The children will also be digging deeper as they explore addition and subtraction patterns, as well as solving problems, by applying their knowledge and understanding. The children will also be learning about the Guy Fawkes story and placing it on the class timeline. As usual there will be lots of child-initiated learning in and outside.
